Cancellation Policy

Course Cancellations

Programs may be cancelled in the event of insufficient registration or for other reasons. In that event, full refunds will be issued to participants who have paid a registration fee. If a program is cancelled because of weather conditions, a recorded message will be available (434-924-1765) the morning of the course. Disclaimer

Accreditation

The University of Virginia School of Medicine is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education to provide continuing medical education for physicians.
