Corrected Heparin Level (CALHEP) LAB4230

Effective July, 2020

- 1. The test may not be added on to a previously drawn sample in the lab.
- 2. The expected turn-around time for the test is 2 hours.
- 3. When high concentrations of oral direct anticoagulant are present in the sample, we are unable to report an accurate corrected heparin level. When this happens, the test will be cancelled with the following comment:

"Interference from Direct Oral Anticoagulant (DOAC) prohibits accurate measurement of Heparin."
