Joint Commission Update H&P Documentation



Situation

- Joint Commission conducted a triennial survey of UVA Medical Center in May of 2024.
- During the survey, a conditional level deficiency was identified relative to History and Physical documentation.
- Timely completion of a comprehensive History and Physical is both a Joint Commission standard and UVA Policy. A missing or incomplete History and Physical IMPEDES THE SAFE DELIVERY OF CARE to our patients.
- If the deficiency is not addressed with a 100% compliance, the organization risks DENIAL OF ACCREDITATION
- Joint Commission will return in the next few weeks to repeat a survey with a focus on History and Physical documentation.




History and Physical Documentation

- A History and Physical must be documented:
 - Within 24 hours of admission
 - Within 30-days of a procedure requiring moderate, deep or general anesthesia (applies to both inpatients and outpatients)
 - In a **HISTORY AND PHYSICAL EPIC NOTE TYPE** (a **PROGRESS EPIC NOTE TYPE** is not acceptable)
- •An Interval History and Physical must be documented:
 - For any patient whereby the initial/admission History and Physical is more than 24 hours old



^{*}Note that many UVA Departments write their H&Ps into Progress Notes – this is no longer acceptable practice.



History and Physical Documentation

- All of the following elements are required per Medical Center Policy in every INITIAL CLINIC/ADMISSION H&P (not the Interval H&P):
 - Chief complaint
 - Relevant PMHx
 - HPI
 - Relevant SHx
 - Allergies
 - Current medications
 - ROS
 - Appropriate PE
 - Conclusion/assessment
 - Plan of treatment
 - Vital signs (if not documented in flowsheet)



History and Physical Documentation

- The following element is required per Medical Center Policy in every INTERVAL H&P:
 - An updated examination of the patient, including any changes in the patient's condition




Immediate Next Steps:

- Starting June 7th, 2024
 - BPA alert for **PROCEDURAL AREA** LIPs and RNs that triggers if there is not an **INITIAL CLINIC/ADMISSION H&P AND INTERVAL H&P** (if more than 24 hours since INITIAL/ADMISSION H&P was documented) in the chart
 - BPA alert for LIPs in INPATIENT AREAS, that alerts if there is not an Admission H&P on file at 12 hours, then Q6 hours until H&P is documented
 - Addition of a sidebar report for RN documentation in Epic that displays last 30 days of H&Ps
 - Data reports developed to identify deficiencies

Anesthesiology and nursing team members have been empowered to stop or delay procedures if H&P notes are not complete. They are not responsible for H&P completion.
